The Automotive Oil Change Association (AOCA) supports the National Conference on Weights and Measures (NCWM)'s adoption of the FALS-supported Items 2302-9 and 2307-1 with recent augmentation proposed by the American Petroleum Institute to make Item 2307-1 fully consistent with Item 2302-9, thereby harmonizing transmission fluid regulation between Method of Sale and Uniform Engine Fuels and Automotive Lubricants regulations within NIST Handbook 130.
